Mantle at Steven Zevitas Gallery

Boston, MA - Steven Zevitas Gallery is pleased to announce a show of new work by Brooklyn-based artist, Hannah Cole. *Mantle* will be on view from Thursday, December 10 through Saturday, January 16, 2010.

Cole is concerned with tension between abstraction and figuration and with visual phenomena that occur at the edges of our perception. In her recent paintings, she renders pieces of the urban environment that normally go unnoticed—the wobble of a trowel mark, a stray UPS note, a random piece of graffiti. By “re-presenting” these random observances into tightly rendered paintings, Cole essentially rehabilitates her subjects and imbues them with aesthetic significance. In her drawings, Cole’s methodology is the same, but her subjects are drawn from the intimate world of her studio.

Cole earned her MFA from Boston University in 2005. Her work has been the focus of five one-woman exhibitions since her graduation, including shows at Greene Contemporary in New York City and at Alpha Gallery in Boston. This is Cole’s first solo exhibition at Steven Zevitas Gallery. Concurrently, there is a presentation of her work at Laconia Gallery in Boston.
